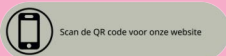

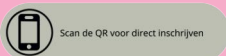

Registration

Intake

In the 6th month of your pregnancy, you will receive an e-mail to make an intake appointment. The purpose of this intake is to match wishes with expectations and to explain exactly what the maternity nurse does.

The birth

General information

Maternity care is reimbursed from basic insurance. The terms and conditions of your policy will tell you, for instance, whether you are entitled to a maternity package, whether you have to pay a personal contribution towards maternity care and what your supplementary insurance policy offers in terms of maternity care.

Developmental care

Under the professional and loving guidance of our maternity nurse, you will learn to care for your baby yourself and support them in their development. Components of this development-oriented care include:

- * Skin-to-skin contact
- * Rest and routine
- * Stimulation reduction
- * Good bonding with your baby
- * Basic way of carrying
- * Rotational nursing
- * Feeding your baby – Precious and Natural
- * Whether you are breastfeeding or bottle feeding, feeding your baby is a precious moment of love and security.

Range of services

Our breastfeeding coaches will be happy to answer any questions you may have about breastfeeding. You can already make use of this service during your pregnancy, obviously in the postnatal time, and up to three months after the birth of your baby.

We give information evenings about breastfeeding to those who are already sure they want to breastfeed. However, this information is also very worthwhile if you are still in doubt whether to breastfeed or bottle feed.

Our maternity nurses will give you all the information and guidance you need. These nurses also follow additional training on nutrition every year. If necessary, we supplement this knowledge with support from your midwife, breastfeeding coach or lactation consultant.
